

Highlights of 21 May 2026 Current Affairs

- Indian Pune-based defence firm has successfully test-fired its 'Suryastra Universal Rocket Launcher System' rocket, which has a range of 300 km and was tested from the range in Odisha.
- Gurnoor Singh Brar, a pacer from Kheowali village in Muktsar, Punjab, has received an India call-up for the upcoming series against Afghanistan in both Tests and ODIs.
- Delhi Lieutenant Governor Taranjit Singh Sandhu has flagged off the first Jatha for the Hemkund Sahib Yatra.
- Microsoft is set to operationalize its largest data centre in India, located in Hyderabad, by mid-2026.
- India and South Korea have signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) on cooperation in the field of cyber defence, training courses between India's National Defence College and Korea National Defence University, and UN peacekeeping cooperation.
- Arsenal won the Premier League championship for the first time in 22 years after defeating the second-seeded Manchester City.
