

## Highlights of 6 May 2026 Current Affairs

The Union Government of India has approved the proposal to increase the number of judges in the **Supreme Court of India** from the current 34 to 38, including the Chief Justice of India, through the *Supreme Court (Number of Judges) Amendment Bill, 2026*.

The **Supreme Court Collegium**, headed by Chief Justice of India **Justice Surya Kant**, has approved the elevation of 10 advocates as new judges of the **Punjab and Haryana High Court**, including Haryana Advocate-General **Pravindra Singh Chauhan**.

**Chief Minister Bhagwant Singh Mann** will undertake a four-day '*Sukhrana Yatra*' from 6 to 9 May. The Yatra will begin with prayers at **Takht Kesgarh Sahib** and conclude on 9 May at **Fatehgarh Sahib**. During the journey, the Chief Minister will also offer prayers at the **Golden Temple in Amritsar, Takht Damdama Sahib in Talwandi Sabo, and Gurdwara Dukhniwaran Sahib in Patiala**.

According to the *World Migration Report 2026* released by the **International Organization for Migration (IOM)**, **India has become the top remittance recipient**, a position it has held since 2010, surpassing the \$100 billion mark. India is followed by **Mexico, the Philippines, and France**.

Former Indian cricketer **Ambati Rayudu** has become the Head of Cricket Operations of the **Hyderabad Cricket Association**.

Indian journalists **Anand RK** and **Suparna Sharma** have won the **Pulitzer Prize 2026** in the *Illustrated Reporting and Commentary* category. They share the award with **Natalie Obiko Pearson of Bloomberg** for their collaborative work titled "*trAPPed*".

The **President of Vietnam** is on a three-day visit to India and has expressed keen interest in purchasing **BrahMos missiles**. India has already supplied BrahMos missiles to the **Philippines** and finalized a deal with **Indonesia** earlier this year.
