

## Highlights of 30 May 2026 Current Affairs

- The Reserve Bank of India, in its annual report, has projected India's real GDP growth at 6.9% for 2026–27 and Consumer Price Index (CPI) inflation at 4.6% for 2026–27.
- The Delhi High Court ordered Google to pay ₹30 lakh in damages to Hindware in a trademark infringement dispute.
- The Reserve Bank of India is in discussions regarding the introduction of polymer banknotes, or plastic banknotes, as they are cheaper to produce and can also be dispensed through Automatic Teller Machines (ATMs).
- Pooja Singh broke the national senior record by winning the gold medal in the high jump at the Asian U20 Athletics Championships.
- Para archer Payal Nag was felicitated by the Odisha Government after her outstanding performance at the World Para Archery Series 2026 in Bangkok.
- Indian shooter Suruchi Inder Singh won the gold medal in the 10m air pistol event at the ISSF World Cup, while Esha Singh secured the silver medal in the same event.
- Defence Secretary Rajesh Kumar Singh has been given additional charge as Chairperson of the Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO), following the end of the tenure of incumbent DRDO Chairperson Samir V. Kamat this month.
- Vice Admiral Ajay Kochhar will take over as the Vice Chief of the Navy, replacing Vice Admiral Sanjay Vatsayan.
- The Defence Minister of India launched a commemorative book on Operation Sindoor. It depicts the personal experiences of 100 officers, sailors, airmen, and soldiers who directly participated in Operation Sindoor.
- The Government has launched a common landing portal, developed by the Department of Financial Services (DFS), to help citizens find unclaimed financial assets. The initiative, titled 'Aapki Pooji, Aapka Adhikar – Your Money, Your Right', aims to empower individuals to claim their rightful financial dues.
- The Government of India has approved two new Special Economic Zones (SEZs) in the Union Territory of Puducherry.
- Bengaluru-based Bellatrix Aerospace has partnered with South Korea's TelePIX for an advanced Very Low Earth Orbit (VLEO) satellite mission.
- Janez Janša was elected again as the Prime Minister of Slovenia for the fourth time.
- Fourteen-year-old Indian-origin student Shery Parikh won the National Spelling Bee 2026 title in the United States.
- The Government of India launched the Port Performance Index and four Digital Maritime Initiatives, announced by Union Minister of Ports, Shipping and Waterways Sarbananda Sonowal during the 37<sup>th</sup> Foundation Day celebration at the Jawaharlal Nehru Port Authority in Mumbai.
- Bengaluru's Kempegowda International Airport has overtaken Mumbai's Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj International Airport to become India's second-busiest domestic airport.
- Indian Railways has launched the new South Coast Railway (SCoR), which has officially become the 18th railway zone, with its headquarters in Visakhapatnam.
- The Kerala Government has launched its first-of-its-kind initiative by establishing a Senior Citizens' Welfare Department in the state.
- India has launched its first SkyCast system at Delhi's Indira Gandhi International Airport to reduce flight delays.

- Goa is celebrating its 39<sup>th</sup> Statehood Day, as it became the 25<sup>th</sup> state of India in 1987.
